

KEROSENE

OTHER NAMES: Kero, Lighting Fluid, Petroleum Solvent

DESCRIPTION

Kerosene is a clear, oily petroleum solvent with a distinctive odour, and is dyed blue. Manufactured by the distillation of crude oil. Not as effective as mineral turpentine at degreasing and is much slower in evaporation rate. Kerosene is an ideal low cost solvent for general purpose use.

USES

LIGHTING AND HEATING FUEL

Kerosene's high energy value and clean burning properties make this product ideal for heaters, lamps, refrigeration units or vaporisation burners. The high standard of purity of this product ensures there are minimal fumes generated on burning.

PAINT MANUFACTURE

A low cost solvent in paint formulations requiring a slow evaporating aliphatic solvent. Also used as a clean-up solvent.
